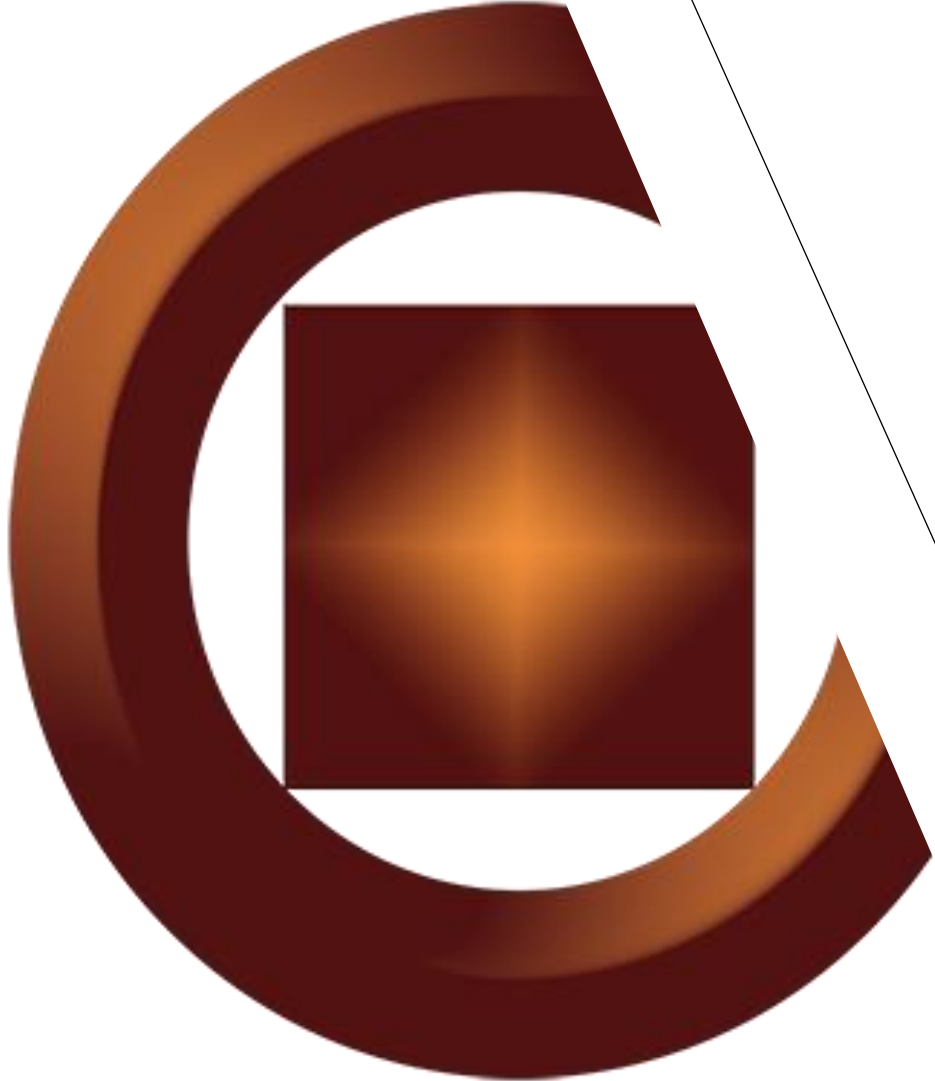

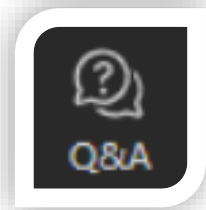

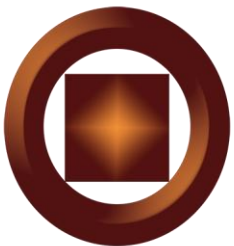

## IMPORTANT TERMS AND ACRONYMS

- Contributor- a contributor is a student, spouse, parent or parent spouse who is providing information on the FAFSA.
- Quickview – The Quickview ISIR is a streamlined version of the full ISIR that includes only the essential information needed to complete verification and resolve C-codes.
- IRS Response Code – This indicates the status of the Federal Tax Information (FTI) transferred from the IRS regarding the filing status for the contributors. This was previously known as the DRT
- Manually Reported Income – This is income that's reported on the ISIR that was entered manually by the contributor and is separate from the income transferred from the IRS.



# WHAT IS VERIFICATION?

Verification is the process of verifying information on the FAFSA application is accurate. FAFSA's are selected for Verification by the FAFSA Processing system (FPS).



# IDENTIFYING VERIFICATION

ISIRs selected for verification will have an “\*” following the SAI. While the asterisk lets you know the file is selected for verification, the Verification Tracking Flag will let you know what needs to be verified.

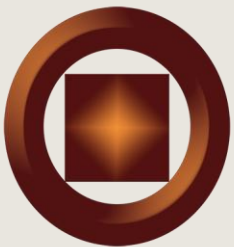
This group verifies the reported income and household information

# FAMILY SIZE HIERARCHY

Family size on the ISIR can be reported in 3 separate areas

- Exemptions – Transferred from the IRS
- Assumed Family Size – Assumption made by FAFSA logic
  - – Assumed Family size overrides the exemptions
- Updated Family Size – Family size updated by student or parent
  - – Updated Family Size overrides the Exemptions and Assumed Family Size

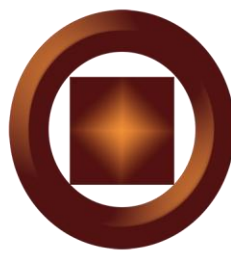

# MANUAL INCOME

Manual income is income reported manually by a contributor. This can occur for multiple reasons.

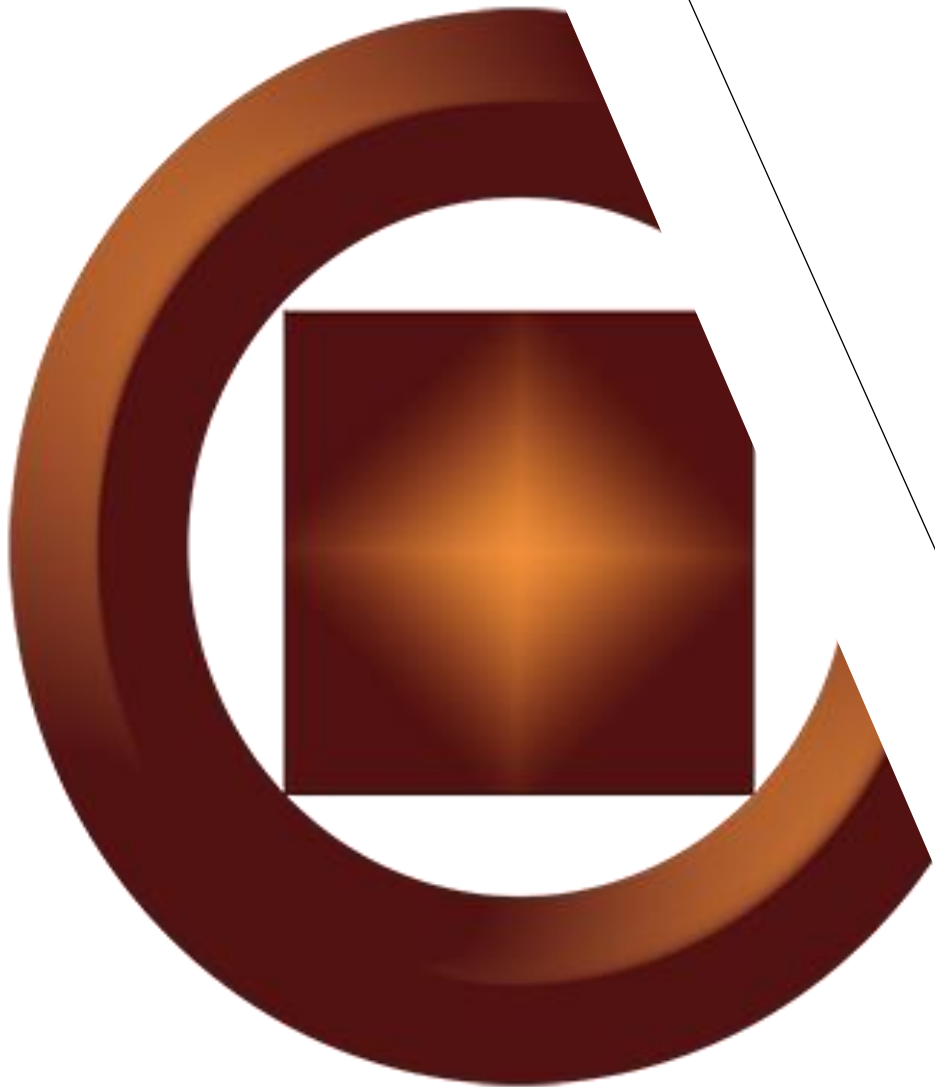
- IRS transfer wasn't successful
- Contributor has had a change in marital status which could cause manual income to be reported
- Contributor is reporting a filing status that conflicts with IRS response
- Contributor filed a foreign return or does not have social security number.
- Income was adjusted due to a professional judgement determination.

Manual income overrides the information transferred from the IRS in the SAI calculation. If you see manual income, it requires documentation to be provided to verify this information.
